Outcomes for Families

The family has the primary responsibility for their children's well-being and development. We will provide respect, honest communication and joint decision making with parents. This will enhance a child's well-being and development. Parents are encouraged to participate in this

home education program by volunteering in class when it's suitable for both the parent and the teacher and being a "hands-on" parent by encouraging and supporting your child's learning from home.

Admissions Application: PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY

1. Helping us understand your child's unique learning needs.

It's required that you schedule a parent/teacher meetup before or after submitting an application. Attending this parent/teacher meeting is a required part of the admissions process. During this meeting, we'll provide an overview of the Home Education program. We're incredibly proud of this teacher-led home-education program and want to ensure you that we will provide a very safe and nurturing environment for your child/children.

Please note that before applying, a new applicant may be considered a candidate for our home-ed program if he or she has no extreme social/emotional, intellectual and/or behavioral issues that require extra support. We want to ensure that each child receives an equal or fair amount of time and attention from the teacher according to the equal amount of fees each parent has committed to paying.

2. Decide which program is right for your child.

We have 3 academic options available for the 2023/24 school year.

a)full day program (\$850/month) 9:00-3:30 daily program, includes reading, writing, math, science, music, art, drama, social studies, health, physical education and social/emotional learning.

b)half day program (\$550/month) 9:00-12:00 This option is ideal for kindergarten students. Grade 1-4 students will be expected to continue their learning during their afternoons at home.

c)at home program (\$200/month) We provide all teaching materials and lesson plans for your child. You would be responsible to pick up materials every other week and implement the learning at home.

3. Complete and submit your application.

All of the necessary paperwork required to complete an application will be provided in person or via email. To complete the admissions application, students in Grades kindergarten to grade 4 that are ideal candidates for the home-ed program need to submit all paperwork in person or via email on or

before May 1, 2023.

During the first couple years of academic learning (Kindergarten to Grade 2), the needs and strengths of a student may not be clearly defined. Once your child is enrolled, we will take this as an opportunity to learn more about your child. Throughout the home-ed program if extra support is required for your child's learning, we will notify you and discuss next steps. We are determined to assist you in choosing the proper program for your child in the next school year. Once the application is completed and we review all applicants, the admissions team will review all pertinent information and contact you to discuss next steps. If we believe that our home-ed program is the best fit for your child's success, we will contact you with the next steps.

For Your Information:

Please Note: A student's placement at this home-ed program will be considered once an application is completed. Upon acceptance, first and last month's tuition is required to guarantee or hold your spot. The deadline for the application is May 1, 2023. Students desiring the full day program will get precedence over students wanting part time enrollment.

Student Placement:

We will consider the specific needs of each child that meets the needs of the entire group of students. When a student is offered a position, we believe that the student's needs can be met in this group setting of grade kindergarten to grade 4. A placement cannot be defined as "first come, first served". It is dependent on the suitability of the position for a specific student. The parent is then required to register your child/children through Ursa Parent-directed Home Education by June 15, 2023 (goursa.education). Please select Carlie McCracken as your child's Home Education Manager.

Good news! There is a homeschooling reimbursement credit: Each grade 1-4 student receives \$850.00 per year in reimbursement funding for their home education program. This money can pay for most of the at home option. If your child is attending in person, this reimbursement will be forwarded to Home Education Consultants to cover costs of school supplies, field trips and our drama/music program. Program Fees:

2023/2024 Home-Education Rates as follows:

Home-Ed Full Program: \$850* payable to Home Education Consultants via cheque or etransfer.

A completed application that has been approved must be accompanied by a \$850 deposit for the first month of school in September plus a deposit of \$850 for the last month of the school year, June 2024. Please ensure all questions are answered, and all required documents are uploaded. An incomplete form will result in a processing delay of your child's application.

Before and After Care:

The Before and After Care program fees will be split equally between all participants in this program so fees are dependent upon how many students sign up. Last year fees were \$80/ month.

If our home-ed program offers a placement and it is accepted, the balance of the tuition is due on the first day of each month from October 1 to May 1, 2024.

The yearly tuition cost is out-of-pocket to parents. Tax receipts will be issued for child care only.

Mid-Year Applicants: If enrolment/re-enrolment occurs after Sept 1st but prior to Sept 30th of the school year, payment of full tuition is required and due on the 1st of each month. The total tuition fee is still required and will not be prorated.

Outstanding balances:

If the outstanding balance is not paid in accordance with the fee schedule, payments will be subject to an interest charge of 2% per month or 24% per annum. Any family who has an unpaid balance with the Home-ed program must pay that outstanding balance before their children will be allowed to register for the subsequent year. In addition, satisfactory payment terms must be in place for the following year.

Withdrawn or expelled:

In the event that a student is withdrawn or expelled from the Home-ed program - ALL Fees and additional fees are non-waivable and non-refundable. No portion of fees, paid or due will be refunded, transferred or canceled in the event of a student's absence, withdrawal or dismissal from Home-ed program. If a student is suspended or expelled, fees will not be refunded by the Home-ed program. The parents will be responsible for locating an alternative placement or arranging for home schooling if an in-school placement for the balance of the school year cannot be found.

Payment Schedules:

Upon enrollment, parents may choose one of three payment schedules: One full payment, two equal payments, or ten monthly payments payable to Home Education Consultant Ltd via cheque or e-transfer (juliemorante@shaw.ca).


